Too there is the safety issue for players and officials when walking through the club spectators, they need to be away from the crowd. 2 of the dressing sheds could be multipurpose, - first aide and gymnasium/storage. The bathroom facilities of the present facilities are poor and there is no privacy. Our officials/ referee's room at present is a 1metre and 1.5 metre closet. It is totally inadequate and our club has been told facilities must be arranged or we could lose games.</p>	
Gymnasium	<p>It is imperative to be competitive in sport to have the necessary facilities available. We have no area at present.</p>	1
Lighting to all fields to QRL standard.	<p>This is a necessity to be in line with QRL/Health and Safety standards.</p>	1
Upper/second storey – restaurant and bar area. With viewing of main field.	<p>For the combined clubs to become financially independent and viable, to support the future of all three clubs to ensure self sufficiency.. We require an area to hold functions, provide meals in a family atmosphere, as well as spectator enjoyment for game days. This is a viable option as Bribie Island has very few function facilities. .Bribie Islands growth is one of the fastest in the Caboolture Shire, with the socio economic group being in the middle range. Verandah – on both sides of the club house	Spectator enjoyment, and would also provide shelter for ground level users.	1
Parking/landscaping	At present parking conditions are inadequate and dangerous.	1
Annex area at front door/foyer.	All weather access to the front door needed.	1
Technical benches on eastern side of the main playing field	Players and officials require all weather shelter, away from the crowd for safety reasons and crowd, spectator enjoyment.	1
Storage facilities.	At present we use a one bay shed, which is inadequate for our needs – we have in place temporarily a shipping container which is not very aesthetic.	1
Mod field made into and international field, addition of mini field at southern end of two existing fields, with irrigation systems to all fields.	An extra training and playing area, for sports competition and training, for our ever increasing numbers.	3
Spectator mound between both fields with shelters and seating	This is a necessity at present we have no such facilities. We need shelter from the weather for our volunteers and players, as well as our spectator base.	1
Covered area to fence line, length of club house	As above, it is imperative that all are protected from the elements.	1
Power supply upgrade	To come into line with QRL standards this will have to be necessary as already we have to limit our power to both fields of a night, when both fields are in use at the one time.	1
Refurbishment of existing club house. To include new bar and seating area,	This will allow for the present bar area to be moved from players and	1

We need an office area, and our present toilet facilities are antiquated, and inadequate for our present membership base.	
Signage	Safety issue, for parking – reverse parking needed as many young players are flighty and are not yet aware of the dangers within high use carpark areas.. No smoking signs, directional signs etc.	1
Children’s fenced/sheltered play area	To broaden the use of the facility, to allow the family atmosphere of sport to permeate to all family members & the wider community.	2
Additional field for touch football at southern end of club house.	Growing membership base – to cater for	7 (President Allan Barraud stated that this would be a 5 year wish)
Grandstand seating around fields.	Spectator enjoyment. We hold international games, which create huge crowds, our seating at present is inadequate.	2
Replacement of tower, stairway.	Very dangerous at present. It also needs to be covered as in wet weather it is very dangerous.(health and safety issue)	1
