Donations

The Queensland Rugby League is committed to the growth of rugby league and assisting community organisations. The QRL receive requests each year from many worthy charities, schools, sporting organisations and other charitable and community groups. While the QRL endeavours to support where ver possible, we are unable to fulfil every request due to the overwhelming volume received.

Preference will be given to the following causes:

- Junior Rugby League Clubs/Rugby League Clubs
- Schools
- Community and/or Charity Groups
- Not-for-Profit organisations

The QRL receive many requests from individuals who have family, friends or associates who have fallen on misfortune. Whilst the QRL endeavour to assist as many causes as possible, an individual's relationship with the game/club will be a factor in determining the success or otherwise of any request.

The following information is required:

- Applications must be in writing and received at least 6 weeks prior to the requested date using the online <u>QRL Charity and donation submission form</u>. Requests cannot be taken over the phone.
- Applications must be on organisation's letterhead (if applicable)
- Where the request relates to a fundraising event on behalf of another not-for-profit organisation, the request must contain an authority verifying the authenticity of the event
- Schools and Individuals that provide documentation as to their support or involvement in Rugby League will be better positioned to receive donations.

Please Note:

- Successful recipients receive either a signed football or signed jersey
- The QRL cannot accept any merchandise sent in for signing. All items will be returned unsigned
- QRL cannot fulfil personal requests for signed memorabilia
- QRL is unable to fulfil monetary requests, requests for game tickets, request for player appearances, or requests for birthdays, weddings or anniversaries.

Additional Information

The Queensland Rugby League endeavour to respond to all requests in writing. In most cases, donations are not made more than once to the same recipient in an attempt to assist as many worthy causes in the community as possible. If a commercial business is running a fundraiser and donating proceeds back to a charitable organisation, the charity's official accreditation and a letter on the charity's letterhead is required for the QRL to consider the request.

All requests must be received in writing using the online QRL charity and donation submission form.
