Background

Activate! Queensland

Activate! Queensland 2019–2029 is the Queensland Government’s 10-year strategy to get more Queenslanders moving, more often. The strategy focuses on further enriching the Queensland way of life; harnessing the pride of our great sporting traditions, embracing our iconic natural environment and building on our strong community foundations to deliver better health and wellbeing outcomes, especially for those who are most vulnerable.

FairPlay is an initiative under the strategy that aims to:

- provide support to enable children and young people facing disadvantage to start or continue to participate in sport and active recreation
- work with the active industry to enable participation pathways including solutions to address cost and location barriers
- provide opportunities for children and young people to be active and develop physical literacy.

FairPlay vouchers

Program objectives

FairPlay vouchers aims to:

- increase regular participation in physical activity for children and young people from low-income families
- contribute to life-long participation in physical activity for target populations.

Funding

Parents, carers or guardians can apply for a voucher valued up to \$150 for eligible children and young people.

These vouchers can be used toward the cost of membership, registration and/or participation fees for eligible activities with registered physical activity providers.

There is a limit of one voucher per child, per calendar year.

Application process

Applications can be made through the QGrants online system.

Parents, carers and guardians will need to:

- check the eligibility of their children against program criteria
- check that the activity (or similar activity) is registered as part of the activity provider directory
- read and understand the FairPlay voucher application terms and conditions
- have access to the QGrants online system (families that have previously applied for a Get Started Voucher can use the same QGrants account).

4. Get ahead of the game by checking your eligibility and finding your preferred activity on the FairPlay Activity Provider List before you apply.
