




STATEWIDE AUTOMATED MATCH REVIEW PROCESS



- Referee Reports to be submitted.
- Clubs to have game footage uploaded to HUDL.
- MRC assemble to review and grade incidents.
- Club Chairperson to have any citings submitted via the Incident Report Form accompanied by ALL required fields completed, including clipped incident footage by 5pm. Incomplete citings will NOT be accepted.



- The Notice of Charge is sent to the affected players club via email. IT IS THE CLUBS RESPONSIBILITY NOTIFY ALL AFFECTED PLAYERS.
- League Chairperson to have any citings submitted via the Incident Report Form accompanied by ALL required fields completed, including clipped incident footage by 5pm. Incomplete citings will NOT be accepted.



- Clubs are to submit the Plea Form on behalf of the player via the automated Notice of Charge pertaining to the individual received Tuesday for those players wishing to plead Not Guilty or Contesting the Grading, by 5pm.
- If no plea is received, you will be assumed as taking the Early Guilty plea.



- Judiciary Tribunals assembled to conduct hearings as a result of Referrals, Not Guilty plea or Grading contests.
- The allowed timeframe for hearings is 7 Business Days from the Notice of Charge.



- The Match Review (including Judiciary) Results Summary will be sent via email to all Clubs. A Notice of Outcome is also sent via the Statewide Automated process. IT IS THE CLUBS RESPONSIBILITY TO NOTIFY ALL AFFECTED PLAYERS.
- Contact your local League Administrator for any particular return to play information regarding dates and eligibility.
